1	People are not able to come to Mumbai office because of Pandemic issue and hence uploading of documents should also be allowed in e tendering portal along with submission of hard copy of documents as per EOI terms & conditions.	Provision of uploading the pre-requisite documents (duly TPIA certified) is available in the technical form section of e.proc. portal. Along with upload of the pre-requisite documents, bidders must also submit the hardcopy with original TPIA certification in the tender box as per EOI conditions. Alternatively, these documents can also be couriered to BPCL's CPO (M) address as the details of which are mentioned in EOI. Bidders must ensure that the hard copy of documents reach before floating quantity bids for this EOI. Alternatively, documents signed digitally by the TPIA agency can also be uploaded over e. proc. site (and in this case bidders are not required to submit hardcopy of the documents)
2	Bidders with multiple distilleries to be allowed to quote from one digital certificate and with single EMD.	Tender condition to be abided by, as this is an OMC requirement.
3	The delivery shall commence within 30 days from the date of Letter of Intent or 10 days from date of issuance of PO by location, whichever is earlier.	Placement of LOI and PO shall be synchronised in such a way that the scheduled date of commencement of supplies starts from 1 <sup>st</sup> December 2020 onwards, or thereafter.
4	If the requisite documents submitted for EOI are expiring in December 2020 then will the allocation for next quarter will be done to the party.	Subject to vendor submitting the documents from time to time. Refer clause no. 4 of Special Terms and Conditions of the EOI. It is further being clarified that such documents should be submitted to BPCL's CPO (M) office, address of which is mentioned in the EOI.

5	If the capacity of the bidders is enhanced during ESY, can bidders participate with enhanced capacities in subsequent EOIs	Yes, Parties can quote as per their enhanced licensed capacities in subsequent EOIs.
6	Will new registration is required to be done if any of the documents submitted in earlier EOI are getting expired.	No new registration is required. Parties to ensure submission of renewed TPIA certified documents/applied for renewal application along with copy of acknowledgement from respective department to BPCL's CPO (M) well before the expiry of the document.
7	Which date is to be put in bid form-Valid from valid to, if party is submitting expired license along with application for renewal and acknowledgement.	Actual dates are required to be put for licenses. For Safety Precaution Letter issued by PESO, the date of letter shall be put as 'from' & 'to'
8	Is BG from cooperative bank acceptable?	For EMD, Bank Guarantee to be submitted in line with EOI terms and conditions and for Security Deposit Bank Guarantee to be submitted as per each OMC requirement.
9	This EOI is particularly for 5 years, a long period. As per tender we have to submit EMD by way of RTGS or Bank Guarantee. We request your good team that EMD shall be allowed to be submitted in the form of FD receipt. This will tend to reduce our financial burden by way saving Bank commission for 5-1/2 years which we have to pay to bank in case of drawl of Bank guarantee. (This is in addition to FD).	Please be guided by EOI terms and conditions.
10	Frequency of EOI to be reduced to monthly from quarterly	OMC will take a call based on market requirement.
