ORDER

S.O.(E)-~~1457~~ In exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Essential Commodities Act, 1955 (10 of 1955), the Central Government hereby makes the following Order to repeal the Sugarcane Press-mud (Control) Order, 1959, published in the Gazette of India vide notification number GSR551/Ess. Com/Press-Mud, dated the 29th April, 1959, namely:-

1. Short title and commencement. – (1) This Order may be called the Sugarcane Press-mud (Control) (Repeal) Order, 2006.
- (2) It shall come into force on the date of its publication in the Official Gazette.
2. The Sugarcane Press-mud (Control) Order, 1959 is hereby repealed.
3. Savings. – The repeal by this Order shall not affect, –
 - (a) the previous operations of the said Order or anything done or omitted to be done or suffered therein; or
 - (b) any right, privilege, obligation or liability acquired, accrued or incurred under the said Order; or
 - (c) any penalty, forfeiture or punishment incurred in respect of any offence committed against the said Order; or
 - (d) any investigation, legal proceedings or remedy in respect of any such right, privilege, obligation, liability, penalty or forfeiture or punishment as aforesaid

and any such investigation, legal proceedings or remedy may be instituted, continued or enforced and any such penalty, forfeiture or punishment may be imposed as if the said Order had not been repealed.
